



2021-22 NISCA National Dual Meet Team Ranking

Sponsored by IST – International Sports Timing

We would like to thank all the teams who participated in the 2021-2022 National Dual Meet Team Ranking program. In total, 239 teams participated this year, up from 197 teams in 2020-2021. On the pages that follow, you will see the 2021 - 2022 final rankings by class, and a Summary of Data page. Some notes about this year's results:

- This year we had 103 girls' entries (up from 85 a year ago) and 136 boys' entries (up from 112 a year ago)
- 32 states are represented, down from 33 last year
- Five states entered 15 or more teams – Pennsylvania (21), Ohio (20), Texas (17), Michigan (17), and Illinois (16)
- Four schools were repeat champs: Brookfield East HS, WI (Class 6 – two straight), Upper Arlington, OH (Class 7 – two straight), St. Xavier, KY (Class 10 - two straight), Santa Margarita Catholic HS, CA (Class 12 - two straight)
- No schools were double-winners (top ranking for boys and girls in their respective class)
- Santa Margarita Catholic HS (CA) had the top overall girls' entry, with 6,957 points, while St. Xavier (KY) was top amongst all boys' entries, with 6,506 points
- Fourteen (14) teams were over 6,000 points (up from 10 last year) and 91 schools had 5,000 or more (65 achieved that total in the 2020-2021 competition)
- In the combined girl/boy ranking, Santa Margarita Catholic HS (13,121 points) finished first, overall
- By enrollment, the top boy/girl combos included Weston HS (MA, Classes 1/5, 8,899 combined points), Ames HS (IA, Classes 2/6, 10,665 points), Upper Arlington HS (OH, Classes 3/7, 11,446 points), New Trier HS (IL, Classes 4/8, 12,151 points), The Westminster Schools (GA, Classes 9/11, 10,679 points), and Santa Margarita Catholic High School (CA, Classes 10/12, 13,121 points).
