2023-24 NISCA National Dual Meet Team Ranking

We would like to thank all the teams who participated in the 2023-2024 National Dual Meet Team Ranking program. In total, 170 teams participated this year, down from 186 teams in 2022-2023. On the pages that follow, you will see the 2023 - 2024 final rankings by class, and a Summary of Data page. Some notes about this year's results:

- This year we had 74 girls' entries (down from 82 a year ago) and 96 boys' entries (down from 104 a year ago)
- 27 states are represented, down from 29 last year
- Three states entered 15 or more teams Michigan (26), Pennsylvania (15) and Texas (15).
- Seven schools were repeat champs: Western Albemarle (Class 2 2nd straight!), Upper Arlington (Class 3 2nd Straight!), Hinsdale Central (Class 8 2nd straight!), McCallie School (Class 9 2nd Straight!), Upper Arlington (Class 7 4th Straight!), Sacred Heart Academy (Class 11 2nd Straight!), Santa Margarita Catholic HS (Class 12 4th Straight!)
- Upper Arlington was the only double-winner (top ranking for boys and girls in their respective class)
- Santa Margarita Catholic HS (CA) had the top overall girls' entry, with 6,299 points, while Hinsdale Central (IL) was top amongst all boys' entries, with 6,401 points
- With the updated Power Points table we saw a drop in entries over 5,000 and 6,000 points. 8 schools (down from 16 in 2022-2023) were over 6,000 points, while 49 schools (down from 78 in 2022-2023) were over 5,000 points.
- In the combined girl/boy ranking, Santa Margarita Catholic HS (12,333 points) finished first, overall
- By enrollment, the top boy/girl combos included Wayland HS (MA, Classes 1/5, 8,409 combined points), Upper Dublin (PA, Classes 2/6, 9,806 points), Upper Arlington HS (OH, Classes 3/7, 10,982 points), Hinsdale Central (IL, Classes 4/8, 11,990 points), Notre Dame Prep (MI, Classes 9/11, 5,877 points), and Santa Margarita Catholic High School (CA, Classes 10/12, 12,333 points).
