



2024-25 NISCA National Dual Meet Team Ranking

Sponsored by IST – International Sports Timing

We would like to thank all the teams who participated in the 2024-2025 National Dual Meet Team Ranking program. In total, 175 teams participated this year, up from 170 teams in 2023-2024. On the pages that follow, you will see the 2024 - 2025 final rankings by class, and a Summary of Data page. Some notes about this year's results:

- This year we had 78 girls' entries (up from 74 a year ago) and 97 boys' entries (1 more than a year ago)
- 32 states are represented, up from 27 last year
- Six states entered 10 or more teams – Michigan (31), Pennsylvania, Illinois (13) and Indiana, Ohio and Texas (10).
- 6 schools were repeat champs: San Marino (Class 1), Upper Arlington (Class 3 - 3rd Straight!), Hinsdale Central (Class 4, 3rd Straight!), Upper Dublin (Class 6), Sacred Heart Academy (Class 11 - 3rd Straight!), Santa Margarita Catholic HS (Class 12 - 5th Straight!)
- Upper Dublin was the only double-winner (top ranking for boys and girls in their respective class)
- Santa Margarita Catholic HS (CA) had the top overall girls' entry, with 6,262 points, while Hinsdale Central was top amongst all boys' entries, with 6,314 points
- With the updated Power Points table (2023) we saw a drop in entries over 5,000 but an increase in schools over 6,000 points. 4 schools (down from 8 in 2023-2024) were over 6,000 points, while 51 schools (up from 49 in 2023-2024) were over 5,000 points.
- In the combined girl/boy ranking, Santa Margarita Catholic HS (11,965 points) finished first, overall
- By enrollment, the top boy/girl combos included Wayland HS (MA, Classes 1/5, 8,064 combined points), Upper Dublin (PA, Classes 2/6, 10,904 points), Verona HS, (WI, Classes 3/7, 10,091 points), New Trier HS (IL, Classes 4/8, 11,851 points), Choate Rosemary HS (CT, Classes 9/11, 9,082 points), and Santa Margarita Catholic High School (CA, Classes 10/12, 11,965 points).
