



## 2025-26 NISCA National Dual Meet Team Ranking

*Sponsored by IST – International Sports Timing*

We would like to thank all the teams who participated in the 2025-2026 National Dual Meet Team Ranking program. In total, 163 teams participated this year, down from 175 teams in 2024-2025. On the pages that follow, you will see the 2025 - 2026 final rankings by class, and a Summary of Data page. Some notes about this year's results:

- This year we had 70 girls' entries (down from 78 a year ago) and 93 boys' entries (down from 97 a year ago)
- 32 states are represented, same as last year
- Four states entered 10 or more teams – Michigan (28), Pennsylvania (17), Indiana and North Carolina (10),
- 6 schools were repeat champs: Upper Arlington (Class 3 - 4th Straight!), Hinsdale Central (Class 4, 4th Straight!), Upper Dublin (Class 6, 3rd Straight), Mercer Island (Class 7), St. Xavier (KY) (Class 10), Santa Margarita Catholic HS (Class 12 - 6th Straight!)
- The Bolles School was the only double-winner (top ranking for boys and girls in their respective class)
- The Bolles School had the top overall girls' and boys' entries, with 5,967 points for the girls and 6,324 for the boys.
- With the updated Power Points table (2023) we continue to see a drop in entries over 6,000 with only 3 schools (down from 4 in 2024-2025) and a drop in schools over 5,000 points, with 50 schools (down from 51 in 2024-2025).
- In the combined girl/boy ranking, The Bolles School (12,291 points) finished first, overall
- By enrollment, the top boy/girl combos included Wayland HS, (MA, Classes 1/5, 8,069 combined points), Upper Dublin (PA, Classes 2/6, 10,283 points), Pittsford Central HS, (NY, Classes 3/7, 9,892 points), Hinsdale Central (IL, Classes 4/8, 11,545 points), The Bolles School (FL, Classes 9/11, 12,291 points), and Santa Margarita Catholic High School (CA, Classes 10/12, 11,670 points).
