RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES FOR BOYS AND GIRLS
Interscholastic Water Polo All-America

1. In order for a swimmer to be considered as a NISCA High School All-American he/she must compete for an interscholastic team and be scholastically eligible as determined by his/her state athletic association or school authority. All athletes must be in at least the 9th grade level of school to be eligible. Athletes are limited to 8 consecutive semesters of eligibility. Fifth year seniors, 7th and 8th grade students are not eligible for consideration. See NFHS National Records Committee Policy Handbook Definition #1.5
2. All applications submitted must be for performances played in regularly scheduled interscholastic water polo games. **USA Water Polo game performances will not be considered!**
3. Only interscholastic coaches may submit applications. COACHES DO NOT HAVE TO BELONG TO NISCA. If the coach does not belong to NISCA, there is a \$40.00 application fee. There is no charge to NISCA members.
4. Applications should be sent to the Water Polo Zone Chair following the interscholastic season. **DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 31ST FOR FALL SEASON, MARCH 31ST FOR WINTER SEASON, AND JUNE 15TH FOR SPRING SEASON AND FINAL DEADLINE.** A \$30 per application late fee will be assessed for applications entered after the season deadline. **AFTER JUNE 15TH, NO FURTHER APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
5. Verification for receipt of applications may only be made if a self-addressed, stamped envelope is included with your application to the Zone Chair.
6. All applicants must be at least 9th grade level of school to be eligible.
7. Zone Water Polo Chairs will make selections to the recommended quota system adopted by the NISCA Water Polo Committee. (The recommended quota system is shown below.)
8. Athletes who are selected to the All-America teams, shall receive one commemorative certificate. These certificates will be sent directly to the athlete.
9. Make a copy of your application for your records and use if your application is lost in the delivery process.
