

The History Of The Power Point Program

This program, initially called the Power Point program, which allows teams to compare themselves in a dual meet format was begun by Joe Groscost (OH) in the 80's. He was succeeded by Bob Klapthor in 1989 and I succeeded him in 1994-95. The first year of results I have found is for the 1984-85 school year.

On the following pages you will see the winner in each class for every year of the program. There have been some changes along the way. For example, a second class for prep school boys and girls was added in 1987-88. Some "across the board" jumps in winning totals occurred at times, the result of our adding a third individual in each event to the entry in 1988-89 or the addition of the 200 Free Relay in 1991-92 which was accompanied by each swimmer allowed to swim a

fourth event.
